LED Streetlight Pilot Project

To save electricity and money, the town is converting all streetlights to LED fixtures. The Freeport Town Council will be discussing the LED streetlight conversion at the Tuesday, February 27th Town Council Meeting at 6:30 PM in the Town Council Chambers.

The LED fixtures come in a variety of colors ranging from a bluish color to a yellowish color. The town is testing two different colors to see what color the community prefers.

The four streetlights closest to the town offices have been converted to LED fixtures. They are labeled as "A" or "B". The labels are on the poles closest to the road.
