**Town Manager's Report**  
**December 1, 2015**

Freeport's Finance Department is proud to announce that we are now issuing motor vehicle plates. The Town has received temporary authorization from the Secretary of State to issue plates, which will be upgraded to full authorization after the

successful completion of a six month probationary period. This authorization required training of staff, as well as inspection

and review by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles of our existing registration agent status, which was successfully completed in October. The Finance Department began issuing plates to the general public on November 1<sup>st</sup>. This means that for most new registrations, residents will no longer be required to make the trek to the BMV office in Topsham to complete their registration. Congrats to the finance department on their successful completion of this certification!

## Winter Reminders from the Public Works Department

The Public Works Department would like to pass on a few reminders to the Freeport residents for the upcoming winter season:

- Freeport residents are allowed **two (2) 5-gallon buckets of sand per storm**. Sand is located adjacent to the silver recycling bullet on Hunter Road in front of the Public Works Facility.
- No parking is allowed on public streets nor in turnarounds during winter storm events – please keep streets and turnarounds clear of vehicles (including trailers, campers, etc.) during a storm. The **winter parking ban is now in effect**, from 11:00pm-7:00am, and will continue until April 15.
- For residents who park vehicles in driveways, **please keep sidewalks clear** so sidewalk machines are not restricted in doing their job.
- On a final note, **please do not push snow into sidewalks or public streets** as this is not only against Maine state law, it is also costly and time-consuming for the Public Works Department to send vehicles and manpower out to go back to clean up a street or sidewalk.




### Food for Fines at the Library!
